

Driving Directions to CINJ

- **From Route 18 North** - Exit onto Route 27 South and proceed to the fourth traffic light (at the New Brunswick train station). Turn right onto Easton Avenue and proceed to the first traffic light. Turn left onto Somerset Street and turn left at the next light onto Little Albany Street. Proceed approximately 200 yards to the CINJ entrance on your left.
- **From NJ Turnpike** - Take Exit 9 (New Brunswick) to Route 18 North, proceed approximately two miles & follow directions above.
- **From Route 1** - Exit onto Route 18 North and follow directions above.
- **From Garden State Parkway** - (from points north) - Take Exit 130 (Route 1 South). Proceed approximately nine miles on Route 1 to Route 18 North. Follow directions above.
- **From Garden State Parkway** - (from points south) - Take Exit 129 (NJ Turnpike), proceed south, and follow directions above.
- **From Route 287** - Take Exit 10 (Easton Avenue/New Brunswick). Continue on Easton Avenue for approximately six miles, until a railroad overpass is visible. Just before the overpass, make a right onto Little Albany Street.

Parking:

- The **Paterson Street Deck** at 124 Paterson St., near the UMDNJ Clinical Academic Building, is your best option for parking. (See #P7 on map. Note: you must pay before you return to your vehicle at the Paystation located in the main elevator lobby.) Follow the green line on map to walking path leading to CINJ
- The **Ferren Mall Daily Deck** at 1 Penn Plaza (across from the train station) (#P3 on map) is also a good option, however, allow yourself 10-15 minutes to walk (uphill) to CINJ. (Note: for GPS and Mapquest directions, use 180 Church Street)
- The **Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital Parking Deck** – Across from CINJ on Little Albany Street. (#P1 on map) Note: this deck is often times full.
- Note: **Valet parking at CINJ will not be an option.** This service is reserved only for patients that have treatment appointments on 06/08. Additionally, valet service will not be available after 5pm.

By Train:

- Take the NJ Transit/Northeast Corridor Line to the New Brunswick Station. At corner of Albany and Easton Avenue, cross Easton Avenue then make a right to Little Albany Street. Make a left onto Little Albany and proceed approximately 200 yards to CINJ.
